COP 21

2015 UN Climate Change Conference of the Parties

- Led to the **Paris Agreement**: a historic, **legally-binding international treaty on climate change to limit global warming to below 2 degrees Celsius**, compared to pre-industrial levels

COP 26

31 October – 12 November 2021, Glasgow, UK

- Follows up the Paris Agreement commitment
- Brings together **governments** from around the world to **agree coordinated action to tackle climate change**
